



➤ **PASS Program Migrant Student of the Year Award**

A current or former migrant student who has completed one or more PASS courses in this school year. State nominees will be forwarded for consideration as the National PASS Migrant Student of the Year and featured in national publications. The National PASS Migrant Student of the Year receives a \$1,000 scholarship from the National PASS Center.

➤ **SLP Leadership Development Project Award**

A person or team using principles and models from the Student Leadership Program *Leaders in Service Replication Guide* to promote student leadership opportunities for local migrant students.
