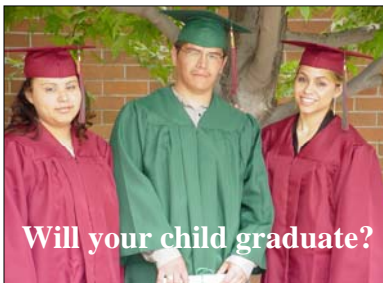


PARENTS... YOU CAN BE THE DIFFERENCE

What are some of the obstacles that our high school students face when obtaining an ideal education ?

- Incomplete or lack of information from the school your child last attended.
- Absences, especially those that are unexcused.
- Lack of parental support or a home environment conducive to doing homework.
- Disruption of a child's education in the middle of the term (semester) because of family demands including work, trips to Mexico, Texas, California, etc.
- Lack of credits to graduate because work in the first high school isn't acknowledged in a second school or because of absences and failing grades.

How can you help your child be successful?
